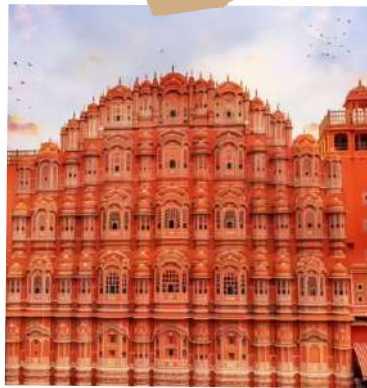

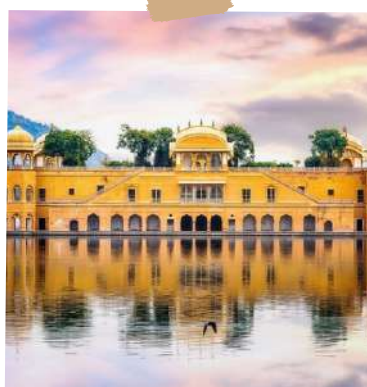
CITY PALACE

Jal Mahal is a stunning architectural marvel in Jaipur! Nestled in the middle of the serene Man Sagar Lake, the palace appears to float on water.

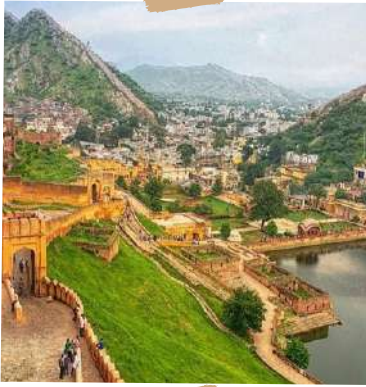


LOCAL BAZAARS

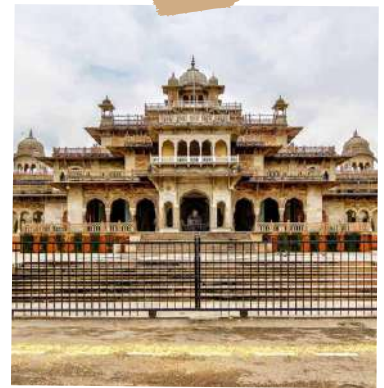
JAIGARH FORT

Jaigarh Fort in Jaipur is famous for the world's largest cannon on wheels, the Jaivana Cannon, which was manufactured at the fort's own foundry.



NAHARGARH FORT

Nahargarh fort was built by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II in the year 1734 for the sake of defence of Jaipur city. Originally this fort was named as Sudarshangarh.



ALBERT HALL MUSEUM

The Government Central Museum, Albert Hall, Jaipur (1876-87) named in honour of the "Prince of Wales" Albert Edward, son of Queen Victoria who laid its foundation stone.



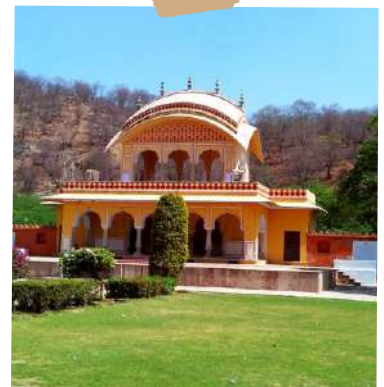
SISODIA RANI KA BAGH

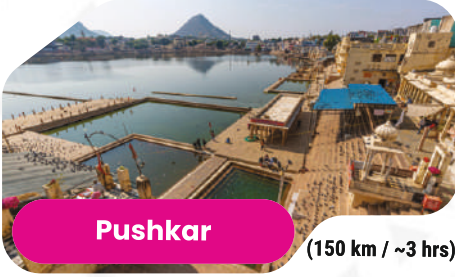


KANAK VRINDAVAN GARDENS

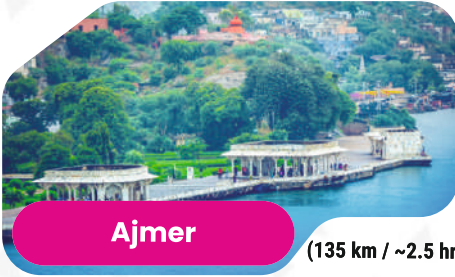
AROUND JAIPUR

(135 km / ~2.5 hrs)

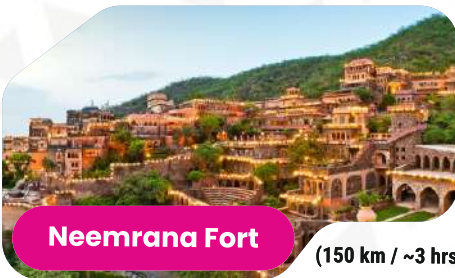

Bhangarh Fort

(85 km / ~1.5 hrs)

LOCATED AROUND 85 KM FROM JAIPUR, THIS 17TH-CENTURY FORT IS KNOWN FOR ITS MAJESTIC RUINS AND MYSTERIOUS LEGENDS, OFTEN CALLED ONE OF INDIA'S MOST INTRIGUING HERITAGE SITES.
